

A World-Record Auction Price for a Case of French Wine

Kenzo Tsujimoto, a Japanese video game company executive, is now seeing if he's got game in the world of fine wine. Mr. Tsujimoto is the chairman of Japan's Capcom Group, maker of such blockbuster games as "Street Fighter" and "Resident Evil." His new Kenzo Estate in Napa Valley will make a variety of wines at different price points, "but its flagship wine is Rindo, a red blend named for the Japanese word for gentians, which is \$75," the Canadian Press reports.
