*Named for the Japanese Gentian or Bell Flower. A delicate creature, only blooming during the months of July and August, with a dark lavender color. A singular expression of the estate, **rindo** comprises an alluring mosaic of Bordeaux varietals from the many vineyard blocks across the property.*
