*The 2014 **rindo** is analogous to the cinematic struggle between beauty and beast. The deep and dark aromatics are tempered by the sensual grace of its palate. Plum, blackberry, and black pepper, as well as a stern minerality define the bouquet, while a delicate blanket of savory tannins lie beneath. This labyrinth of a red Bordeaux blend is drinkable now, but one can expect this wine to be in perfect harmonious balance within 5 years.*
